**Divyarakshalayam** is a registered charitable Society devoted to giving all possible service to the poor mentally sick brethren in the society. Tomy, a youngster who was in his early twenties full of dynamism and courage set out for this new mission of sheltering the wandering mental patients. Empathy moved Tomy to take up this difficult task. As you know great risk is involved in such a mission. There was a man named Mani, literally on the street in our hometown Thodupuzha, Idukki(dt.), Kerala, South India for about fifteen years. He was a wandering mental patient. He had in a sense lost his mind, a fierce looking man and a constant nuisance in the town. The public abused him in return. He was indeed a question mark to the social conscience. No one could figure him out and knew what to do with him.



Tomy picked him up from the street and hospitalized him with the help of another organization named 'Snehadeepam', Thodupuzha. The psychiatric treatment that was given to him brought about good results. He was never again back to his same old misery. When he was discharged after one and a half months of treatment, he was rehabilitated in Tomy's home for about two years. On June 15th 1996, when the number of patients increased to four, Tomy realized that it was necessary to register it as a Trust. So "**Divyarakshaka Social and Charitable Trust**" was registered in the year 1996, and later, in 1999 it was registered as a Charitable society according to the society act. Divyarakshalayam is situated on the land so generously donated by Late Mr. Mathew Odackal, Father of Tomy.

'Vasu' a mental patient was living on the streets of Vazhakulam, eating grass and earthworms for food. He was such a dreadful man that nobody dared to take a glance at him. Initially, he was treated in a hospital for few months and then accommodated at this home. He was taken care of like a little child. He is fully cured now and being dearly called as 'Vasukuttan.'
